ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Six nights in the season of Iceland's longest nights, arranged so the group is always somewhere worth waiting. The days go to glaciers, geothermal valleys and the black coast of Vík, and every evening is left open for the sky, from a turf-roofed lodge in the Golden Circle to the lava fields of the Blue Lagoon.

Daylight belongs to Þingvellir and Brúarfoss, Strokkur and Gullfoss, the waterfalls of the south coast, a Katla ice cave reached by super-jeep and the black sand of Reynisfjara, with the Raufarhólshellir lava tube on the way back west. The nights belong to the sky, watched from a turf-roofed lodge in the Golden Circle and, on the final evening, from the lava field at the Blue Lagoon.

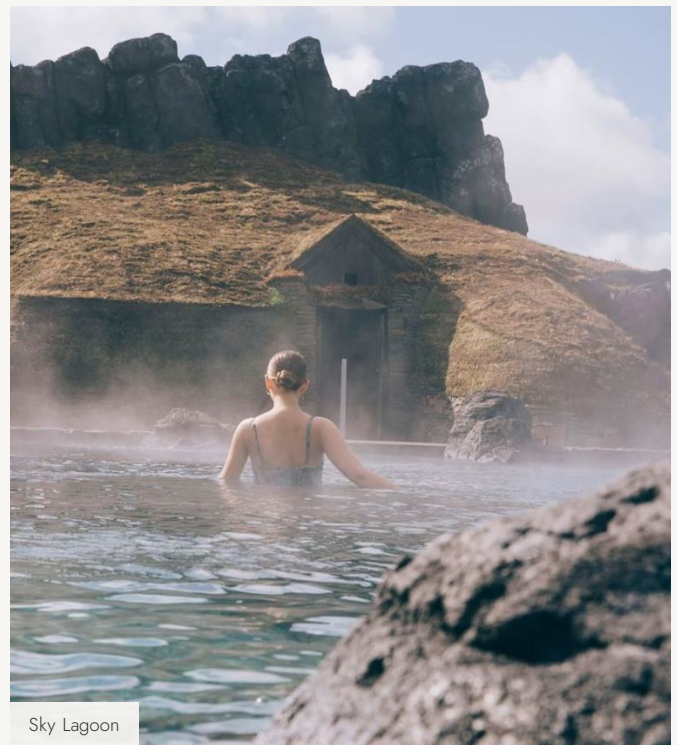

WHAT MAKES THIS ITINERARY SPECIAL

— AURORA SEASON

Evenings kept open for the Northern Lights, watched from a countryside lodge under wide dark skies and, on clear nights, across the south.

— GEOTHERMAL BATHING

The Sky Lagoon ritual above the sea, private hot tubs at Torfhús and the mineral waters of the Blue Lagoon at the close.

— A KATLA ICE CAVE

A super-jeep onto Kötlućökull and inside one of the few ice caves open through the winter, where black ash and blue ice fold together.

— FIRE AND ICE

Þingvellir between the continents, Strokkur erupting at Geysir, the black sand and basalt of Vík, and a lava tube formed 5,000 years ago.

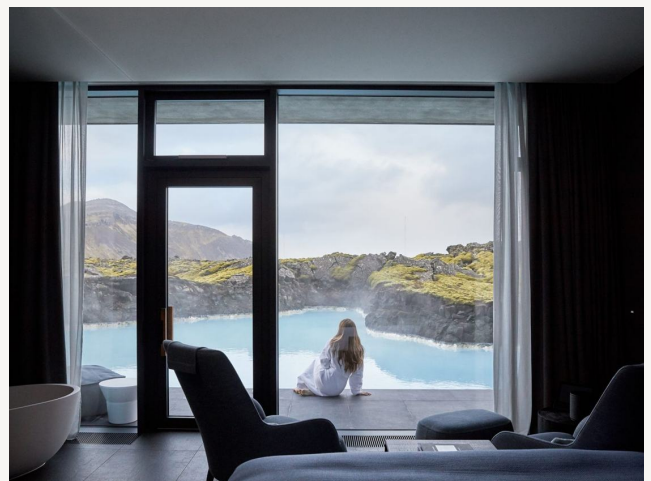


HOTEL LOA

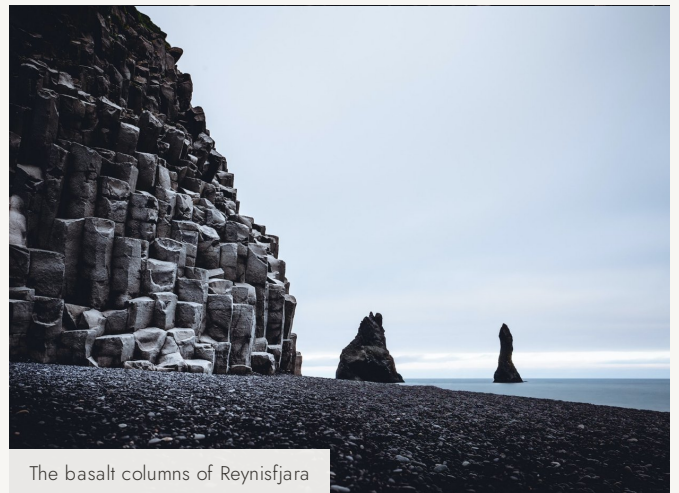
